- 2. Further notes that he was a renowned journalist and a political prisoner on Robben Island.
- 3. Acknowledges that he hailed from Durban and was a member of the Muslim Youth Movement and edited its newspaper.
- 4. Further acknowledges that amongst other media houses, he worked as a journalist at the Muslim News, now Muslim Views during the 1980s turbulent times under apartheid South Africa.
- 5. Recognises that he was a MK operative and the last political prisoner on Robben Island to have occupied President Nelson Mandela's old cell on the Island.
- 6. Further recognises that he was among the last group of political prisoners to be released from Robben Island and the only journalist imprisoned in 1989.
- 7. Acknowledges his commitment for justice and as a journalist his reporting was always in favour of justice.
- 8. that the House express condolences to his daughter Shaista Rohan-Toefy and grandchildren and the extended Rohan family.
